

Biotrend Signs UN Women Convention!

Biotrend signed the "UN Women" (United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women) convention. Underlining that while the rate of female employees in Biotrend was 10% at the end of 2022, this rate increased to 22% in February 2023, Vardı added that their goal is to increase the rate of female employees to 30% excluding the board of directors by the end of 2023.
